Her paintings are included in the permanent collections of the Hudson River Museum, United States Embassy Beijing, United States Embassy Windhoek, Namibia, Tampa Museum of Art, and Perez Art Museum Miami.

Condon's public commissions include MTA Art & Design Percent for Art, Norte Maar Collaboration for the Arts, and Tribeca Film Institute's Storefront Art Recovery Initiative (STAR).
