Special Event: Saturday June 27th 1-6pm, Drop in on two artist-led workshops : plein air painting on the 1st Floor and exquisite corpse drawing on the 2nd Floor. All are welcome.

Two shows:

2ND FLOOR: Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf : new works by James Esber, Jane Fine and J. Fiber (a pseudonym for the artists' collaborative drawings).

The three bodies of work exist at the border between figuration and abstraction; each one a stew pot of pop culture and art historical references.

1ST FLOOR: Seven Women Chase Icebergs : Friendship, and Landscape in Pouch Cove
